#### **NAIROBI**

## Wednesday May 27 - Nairobi

Arrive in Nairobi and meet up with the group. Overnight at the <u>Town Lodge</u>.

## Thursday May 28 - Nairobi

Trip members have the opportunity to visit All Saints' Cathedral and other sites including the David Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage, the Karen Blixen Museum, Uhuru Park, and the City Center.

Overnight at the Town Lodge.

### **MARSABIT**

## <u>Friday May 29 – Mission Aviation Flight</u> (MAF) to Marsabit

Visit Diocese of Marsabit Anglican Campus. Overnight at the <u>Jirime Hotel</u>, Marsabit.

## Saturday & Sunday May 30-31- Marsabit

Visit to the St. Andrew's High School Property and worship at the Cathedral. Visit local churches and the other schools in the Diocese. Overnight at the Jirime Hotel, Marsabit.

#### **SOLOLO**

## Monday June 1 - Sololo

Travel north to visit Tumaini Academy. Lunch at the Vicarage before returning to Marsabit before dark.

Overnight at the Jirime Hotel, Marsabit.

#### **SAMBURU**

## <u>Tuesday June 2 – Samburu National Park</u>

Travel by land to Samburu National Park. Late afternoon game drive before dinner overlooking the river.

Overnight at <u>Samburu Game Lodge</u>.

## <u>Wednesday June 3 – Samburu National Park</u>

Early morning game drive before worshipping in a local church. Relax in the afternoon before a late afternoon game drive.

Overnight at Samburu Game Lodge.

# <u>Thursday June 4 – Samburu National Park to Nairobi</u>

Take one last morning game drive (optional) before traveling by land to Jomo Kenyatta Airport for return to the US. Lunch will be en route at the Trout Tree Restaurant near Mt. Kenya.

Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta Airport for your evening departure flight back to the USA.

Alternatively, spend one more night in Nairobi and fly home on Friday June 5.

**Ground Costs:** \$3,250/pp including lodging (double occupancy) in-country transportation, and most meals. Travelers are responsible for passport, visa, inoculations and malaria prophylaxis, admission fees to museums and game parks, traveler's insurance, souvenirs, alcohol, some meals, and extra excursions.
